## CAMPING

### **On-Site:**

Camping is permitted in designated areas only. Reservations taken for a minimum two-night stay, paid in advance. You may access the online reservation system between the dates of May 27 and July 1. In the event that any non-reserved campsites remain after the reservations close, these sites will be available beginning Thursday morning, July 29 at 9 a.m. on a first-come, first-served basis. Dedicated hook-ups (power and water) are very limited and must be booked for all 4 nights. Partial hook-ups (power/water and power only) are limited. Only 350 sites total are available per night. There is no sewage or gray water disposal on the site. Sanikans with washing stations will be available in the camping area Thursday to Monday morning. Restrooms and showers are available inside the Expo Center grounds from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m..

Fees charged per site, per night, Thursday through Sunday night. Total fee for entire stay charged at time of reservation or upon arrival. No refunds are available for camping fees. Please check in at Campground Office before proceeding to camping area.

From the North, go south on Interstate 405 to the Maple Valley Highway (State Route 169) and then south to Enumclaw.

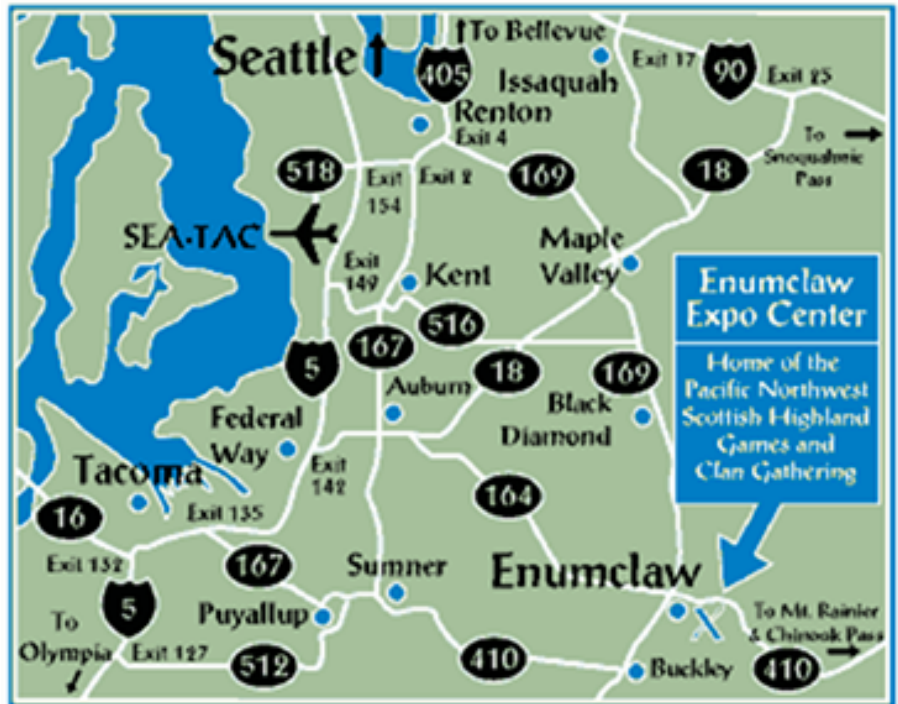
From Interstate 90, take State Route 18 to Maple Valley and then State Route 169 south to Enumclaw.

Once in Enumclaw, follow signs to the Expo Center. The grounds are at the southeast edge of Enumclaw, just off State Route 410 at 284<sup>th</sup> Avenue Southeast.

From Tacoma, take State Route 167 and then go east on State Route 410 to 284<sup>th</sup> Avenue Southeast.

From the South, take State Route 512 to Sumner and then State Route 410 to 284<sup>th</sup> Avenue Southeast.

**ATHLETIC RULES**

1. Championship sanctioned by, and governed by the rules of, the SAAA, using SAAA tiebreakers and winged trig, and adjudicated by an SAAA certified judging and scoring staff.
2. Competition is limited to the 12 highest-ranked North American athletes that apply; however, neither Canada nor the U.S. will be represented by fewer than 4 athletes from the game's ranking page at [www.nasgaweb.com/dbase](http://www.nasgaweb.com/dbase).
3. Each application will be added to a waiting list. Applicant information will be evaluated and the 12 top ranked applicants will be invited to compete. Invitations will be emailed by June 30, 2010.
4. The Athletics Committee reserves the right to change or eliminate scheduled events.
5. Competitors **must** wear kilt, long hose and games shirt. Competitors receive shirt when arriving to compete.
6. **In all distance events, footwear must be compatible with an Astro-turf throwing surface.**
7. For safety, the distance throws will be restricted to a 60 degree sector with hammer throws further restricted to a 40 degree sector. The implement must land within the inner edges of the lines marking the sector to be scored.
8. In the event of a tie in overall points, placing will be determined by number of events won, then seconds, thirds, etc.
9. Decisions of the Judges and Athletics Directors are final.
10. It is the responsibility of the competitor to pick up all awards at the Games, or request them in writing by October 31, 2010.
11. Gate passes and any advance tickets purchased will be mailed by July 15, 2010. Everyone must have a pass or ticket to get on field.

**AWARDS:** \$1,500 / 1,000 / 900 / 800 / 750 / 700 / 650 / 600 / 550 / 500 / 450 / 400. Championship events \$200 / 100 / 50 each event.

**Transportation:** Air travel arrangements will be made by the athlete at the most economical rate and the invoice must be submitted for reimbursement. Athletes receive a \$100 allowance to acquire transportation between Sea-Tac airport and Enumclaw. Athletes living within 300 miles of Enumclaw may opt for a 55 cent a mile travel allowance and \$100 for expenses.

**Lodging:** Two to a room lodging is provided at no cost for the nights of July 30 and July 31. Athletes requiring lodging for the night of August 1 must so indicate on the application form.

**Records:** Athletes setting Games record receive \$100, \$400 bonus if setting national record (when posted), \$900 bonus if setting North American record (when posted). One record per implement for weekend.
