- Pipe bands must submit Competition Roster that includes name and position in band. (i.e., P/M, D/S, Piper, Drummer). Rosters may be submitted via Email: [burpee@comcast.net](mailto:burpee@comcast.net). Entries will not be accepted without Competition Roster.
- All competing bands playing in Opening and Closing Massed Bands must be in competition dress.  
 Tunes to be played during Closing Massed Bands in order are:

 Tunes at the Halt: Amazing Grace, Barren Rocks of Aden, Bonnie Dundee

 Tunes at the Halt: Barren Rocks of Aden, Bonnie Dundee

 Pipe bands will not have to stand through Opening Ceremonies.
- During massed bands, pipe bands, drum corps and individual competitors may not tune or play during Opening and Closing Ceremonies.
