APPLICATION AND COMPETITOR ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. ON-LINE ENTRY ONLY at www.sshga.org. If online entry is not possible, Contact dance registrar Jacki Ochs: jacki_ochs@yahoo.com.
- 2. Fees must accompany applications and entry forms. NO REFUNDS.
- 3. All application responses and ON LINE entries must be received by July 15, 2025. DOUBLE ENTRY FEES JULY 1-15.
- 4. Late applications, entries, field entries and competitor substitutions will not be accepted.
- 5. Competitor numbers will be picked up on the field at the Dance Competition/Scoring tent. Gate passes, Dance Tent Authorization, and any advance admission tickets purchased will be sent (e-mailed preferred) by July 10, 2025...
- 6. Everyone must have a gate pass or an admission ticket to get on the field Saturday or Sunday.

DANCING RULES

- 1. Competition governed by RSOBHD rules. (ROYAL SCOTTISH OFFICIAL BOARD OF HIGHLAND DANCING)
- 2. Age is as of July 26, 2025.
- All competitors must include their RSOBHD Registration number on the entry form, present the card in order to collect competitors' numbers and to receive medals or prize money.
- 4. **Washington State Events: Open only to Premier Class dancers who are currently residing in Washington State.
- 5. Class splits will occur at close of entries.
- 6. First entered will be last to dance. Competitors not present when scheduled or causing delay will forfeit his/her entry in the event.
- 7. Competition start times are as follows:

Saturday: Pre-Premier Classes begins at 9am, Premier Classes begin at approximately 10:00am

Sunday: Premier Classes begin at 10am, followed by Washington Only & Choreography

10. Choreography is open to Premier dancers only and must be either Highland or National in appearance, music and theme.

Choreography "A" (open to individual performers). Choreography "B" (open to groups of 2 or more).

LIMITED to the first 15 combined total performances.

- a) Name of Choreography dance and names of all competitors required on entry form.
- b) Competitors must supply their own piper or CD.
- c) Classes may be split by age.
- d) Length of performance should not exceed 2 minutes
- 11. Aggregate trophy or plaque awarded in every class each day (except Primary per RSOBHD)
- 12. All dances on Saturday will count toward Saturday trophy
- 13. All dances on Sunday will count toward Sunday trophy
- 14. Pre-Premier Competitors who receive a top 3 Placing (Beginner, Highland Only) (Novice and Intermediate, all) will receive a single stamp on SCOT DANCE Card dancing per RSOBHD.
- 15. The decisions of the judges are final. Protests must be made in writing and in the hands of the Games Executive Secretary along with a \$25.00 fee prior to the end of the day's competition. If the protest is sustained, the fee will be returned.
- 16. It is the responsibility of the competitor to pick up all awards at the Games, or request in writing by October 29, 2025. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of all awards.
- 17. Competitor numbers, with dance card verification (paper copy or photo of dance card not allowed), will be picked up on the field at the Dance Competition/Scoring Tent.
- 18. Gate pass, schedule, Dance tent authorization, and any advance admission tickets you have purchased will be e-mailed by July 10, 2025. Everyone must have a gate pass or admission ticket to get on the field.

AWARDS (all money awards paid by check)

Aggregate trophy or plaque awarded in every class each day (except Primary per RSOBHD).

Perpetual trophies awards listed in the Games Program

Choreography events receive medals and trophy

Non-money events: Medals

Washington Only events: Money awards for all ages

All Premier classes 16 Years & Over receive money awards

Personal and Competitor tent site registration for Dancers.
